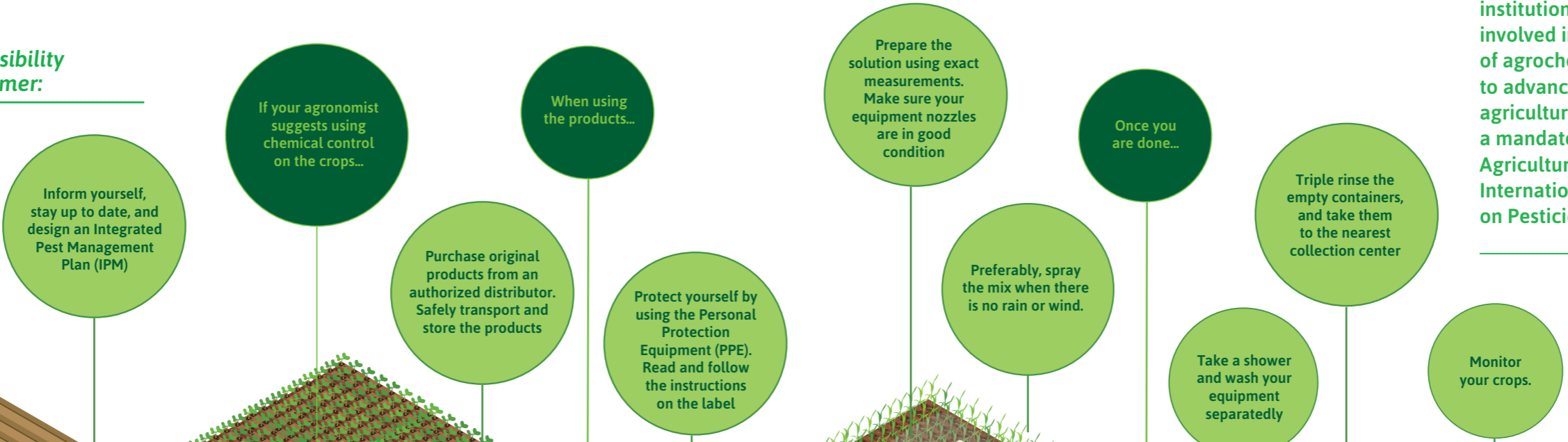


# The responsible use of pesticides is a shared and extended responsibility.

## Which part are you responsible for?



### Responsibility as a farmer:



The participation of every institution and individual involved in the responsible use of agrochemicals is a key factor to advance towards a sustainable agriculture, while also being a mandate by the Food and Agriculture Organization's, FAO, International Code of Conduct on Pesticide Management.

### Responsibility as:

#### Governments municipal, regional, and national authorities:

Regulate the availability, distribution, and usage of pesticides in your respective country.

#### Industry and pesticide distributors/dealers:

- Promote and support the responsible use of pesticides, which includes a responsible and proper final disposal of the container.
- Design and distribute resources about Good Agricultural Practices, GAPs.

#### Governments, Pesticide Industry, and Pesticide Application Equipment Industry:

Develop and promote equipment that reduce to the minimum acceptable possible health and environmental risks.
